Thank you for using the Arthrex Research Portal (**“Arthrex Research Portal”**) for research activities, provided by the Arthrex group, headed by Arthrex, Inc., 1370 Creekside Blvd., Naples, Florida, 34108, USA, and their affiliates (collectively **“Arthrex”**).

Arthrex recognizes the importance of data privacy and is committed to protecting the confidentiality and integrity of your personal data.

This Privacy Notice for the Arthrex Research Portal (**“Privacy Notice”**) describes the types of personal data we may collect, how we may process and use personal data in the research funding process at Arthrex, and the specific rights you have with respect to your personal data. This Privacy Notice is intended to comply with all applicable laws and regulations. Any terms defined in such applicable laws and regulations have the same meaning when used in this Privacy Notice.

1. Name and Address of the Data Controller and Contact Details for the Data Protection Officer

As the Controller, Arthrex is responsible for the processing of your personal data.

2. Data Categories, Purpose, and Legal Basis

Upon registering within the Arthrex Research Portal, Arthrex may store and process your personal data, including but not limited to:

- Name
- Job title
- Address
- Telephone number
- Email
- Resume, and/or other data provided by the applicant (**“applicant data”**) in order to fund the research process

Arthrex will store and process applicant data in order to perform the respective contractual relationship with respect to the funding (legal basis is contract performance) and to protect our legitimate interest in documenting contractual agreements and correspondence for establishing, exercising, or defending related legal claims, as well as in preventing and prosecuting misuse of the Arthrex Research Portal (legal basis in exercise of legitimate interest) and fulfilling statutory documentation and document retention obligations (legal basis is compliance with legal obligations to which the Controller is subject). Arthrex will retain personal data provided to the Arthrex Research Portal for a limited amount of time, as per the applicable local statute of limitations provisions.

3. Recipients and Categories of Recipients

Applicant data may only be shared with Arthrex employees, located in the United States or other locations where Arthrex subsidiaries are established, who may have access on a need-to-know basis,

upon request. When such applicant data is transferred to an unsecure third country, applicant data is protected through the implementation of technical and organizational measures, including standard contractual clauses.

4. Your Rights

Any individual whose applicant data has been provided to Arthrex has the right to obtain confirmation from Arthrex as to whether applicant data concerning him or her is being processed. In this context, an individual has the right to request that Arthrex corrects inaccurate personal data and completes any incomplete applicant data; the right to request the erasure of certain applicant data, such as personal data which is no longer necessary for legitimate purposes; the right to request the restriction of the processing of certain applicant data, such as personal data which is claimed to be inaccurate; and the right to data portability. An individual also has the right to

object to certain processing activities of his or her applicant data. Any individual is entitled to submit a complaint with a supervisory authority. This may be the supervisory authority within the jurisdiction in your domicile or with general personal jurisdiction over Arthrex.
